





# Rialto seamlessly fits into our existing workflows

For John Lassiter, Director of Library Services at Georgia Northwestern Technical College, becoming a Rialto library was the logical next step in a long series of improvements. "I'd love to say choosing Rialto was the result of a big event, but really it was a process."

John is constantly on the lookout for ways to improve the acquisition process because "acquisitions is labor-intensive for librarians". All the steps to track and synchronize information between ordering workflows and the library's ILS (Integrated Library System) are unwieldy and time-consuming. Recognizing the need for greater efficiency, John eagerly adopts new technology when he sees the potential to streamline and improve the workflow.

"Years ago, I discovered embedded order data. At the time, that made things easy." When Georgia Northwestern went live with Ex Libris Alma Higher Ed cloud platform, John saw an opportunity to change how the library did acquisitions. "I completely revamped how we did acquisitions which is why we started to use OASIS."

The real-time acquisition API between ProQuest OASIS and Alma was the main draw and offered John's team the next level of innovation to the acquisition workflow. "It worked really well, and I thought that was best thing ever."

When John heard about Rialto, still in development by ProQuest and Ex Libris teams, he knew it would be the next logical step for his library. "I knew that having our primary book vendor integrated within the ILS would mean that you are not always bouncing back and forth between two systems. *Rialto was closing the loop in terms of automation, so I was ready to go for it.*"



## Revolutionizing ebook buying

When ebooks were first made available to academic libraries for purchase, they were offered as a collection of several hundred or thousand titles at a time. This made them very difficult for libraries to deal with, making ebooks annoyingly "high maintenance" for librarians.

With ProQuest involved in the development of Rialto, I realized it could revolutionize our purchase of individual ebook titles. We can now develop our library's collection on title-by-title basis, whether print or electronic."

Purchasing individual ebook titles provides libraries with the option to spend their annual budget in smaller transactions. Buying ebooks in big collections is easiest at the beginning of a fiscal year. As funds dwindle through the year, the purchase of a big ebook collection was out of question. "With title-by-title ebook purchasing through Rialto, I am able to get librarians to focus budget dollars to specific needs and to fill gaps in their collection."



#### Sophistication through simplicity

"I like Rialto's sophistication is based on how simple it is to use. We librarians like to add things, add more and more options for our students so we know what a challenge it is to keep things simple."

For example, "one of the strengths of Rialto is the facets. The ability to go through and quickly limit its giant marketplace is very useful."

All seven of Georgia Northwestern's librarians are now using Rialto, and John noted that Rialto makes it even easier to work remotely. "It was very quick to get them up to speed. *Rialto is simple to understand which makes it easy to use.*"
