In the fall of 2020, the Munday Library permanently removed the print collection from circulation, choosing instead to adopt an electronic only collection. While this change met many needs, including providing space for growing departments, it still upset some faculty.

The decision to move to all electronic resources had already been made when Bonnie joined St. Edward's so she could see an opportunity to improve relationships with faculty.
